Adding two numbers up to five digits word problems

- a. Delilah’s income last week = \$28,113,  
Her income this week = \$72,341.  
Therefore, total income she made last week and this week =

Delilah’s income last week+ her income this week.

$$\begin{array}{r} 72,341 \\ + 28,113 \\ \hline 100,454 \end{array}$$

So, she made \$100,454 last week and this week.

- b. Both classes collected 174,543 candies all together.

- c. Archer picked 474 fruits.

- d. There are 173,037 fish in the pond in all.
