Multiplication Word Problems

a.

Last week, Leilani, Charlotte, Quinn, Gabriella and Killian bought 3 cupcakes each.

How many cupcakes did they buy altogether?

b.

Yesterday, the preacher bought 8 tickets for a church concert.

If each ticket cost \$8, what was the cost of 8 tickets?

c.

After the heavy wind this evening, Erick and his 7 friends picked 11 apples each from his friend's orchard.

How many apples did they pick altogether if they decided to count all the apples?

d.

The class is doing an arts activity.

If there are 9 groups of 5 pupils, how many pupils are there in the class?

e.

Yesterday, my mother bought 4 bunches of bananas.

If there were 8 bananas per bunch, how many bananas did she buy?

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- a. Number of people = 5.
Number of cupcakes each person bought = 3.
Therefore, number of cupcakes they have bought in all =
Number of people \times Number of cupcakes each person bought.
 $3 \times 5 = ?$
 $3 \times 5 = 15$

So, they bought 15 cupcakes altogether.

- b. Each the 8 tickets cost \$64.

- c. They picked 88 apples altogether.

- d. There are 45 people in the class.

- e. She bought 32 bananas .
