Estimating differences word problems

- a. Number of candies they sold during the Halloween month = 8,236,142,
 Number of candies they sold during the month immediately after Halloween month = 2,111,384.
 Therefore, the estimated number of more candies they sold in the month of
 Halloween than the month immediately after Halloween =
 candies they sold during the Halloween month + candies they sold after Halloween month

They sold about 6,000,000 more candies in the month of Halloween than the month immediately after Halloween.
