1. Randel bought two houses for \$769,000 and \$454,560. How much did he spend in all?
2. Larry played a motor bike game online and scored 952 points in the first round and 648 points in the second round. The game was over after the second round. How many more points did he score in the first round than in the second round?
3. Peter owns a very big chicken farm. 7,630 chickens have started laying eggs, but the other 557 have not. How many chickens are there on the farm?
4. Packer has 18 pairs of shoes. Yesterday, his dad brought him 6 more pairs. Upon this, he still wants 10 more pairs. If he gets them, how many pairs of shoes will he have now?
5. Last week, mom made 125 cookies. Dad ate 54 of them throughout last weekend. If she made 168 cookies this week,
 - a. How many cookies did she make in all last week and this week?
 - b. How many of last week cookies are still left?
 - c. How many cookies are actually left?
6. Mrs Thomas is a warehouse manager. Today, he got an order to deliver 1,256 bags of rice to different stores in the city. She delivered 210 bags to matter's store and 305 bags to Mr James' store.
 - a. How many bags of rice has she delivered in all?
 - b. How many more bags of rice does she have to deliver to complete the order?
7. Jerry has 256 soccer cards. His brother, Jude, has 531. How many more soccer cards does Jerry have than Jude provided their father gave Jerry 300 more soccer cards yesterday?

Add and subtract whole numbers: word problems

1. Randel bought two houses for \$769,000 and \$454,560. How much did he spend in all?

To solve this, add up the 2 amounts he bought the houses.

 + \$454,560 \\
 \hline
 \boxed{\$1,223,560}
 \end{array}$$

So, Randel spent **\$1,223,560**.

2. So, Larry scored 304 more points in the first round.
3. So, there are 8,187 chickens on the farm.
4. So, he will have 34 pairs of shoes now.
5. a- So, she made 293 cookies in all.
 b- So, 71 of last week's cookies are still left.
 c- So, 239 cookies are actually left.
6. a- So, she has delivered 515 bags in all.
 b- So, she still has 741 more bags of rice to deliver.
7. So, Jerry has 25 more soccer cards than Jude.
